

Planting by the Moon

Plant vegetables that produce their crops **ABOVE** ground during the **WAXING** period.

This period begins with new moon and extends to full moon.

From the new moon to the 1st quarter plant leafy vegetables, celery and herbs like parsley, basil and chives.

From the 1st quarter to full moon - tomatoes, peas, beans, corn, eggplant, pumpkin, and capsicum.

For vegetables that produce **BELOW** ground, plant in the **WANING** cycle, between full moon and the last quarter.

From full moon to the last quarter - potatoes, carrots, parsnips and radish.

From the last quarter to the new moon - no planting
